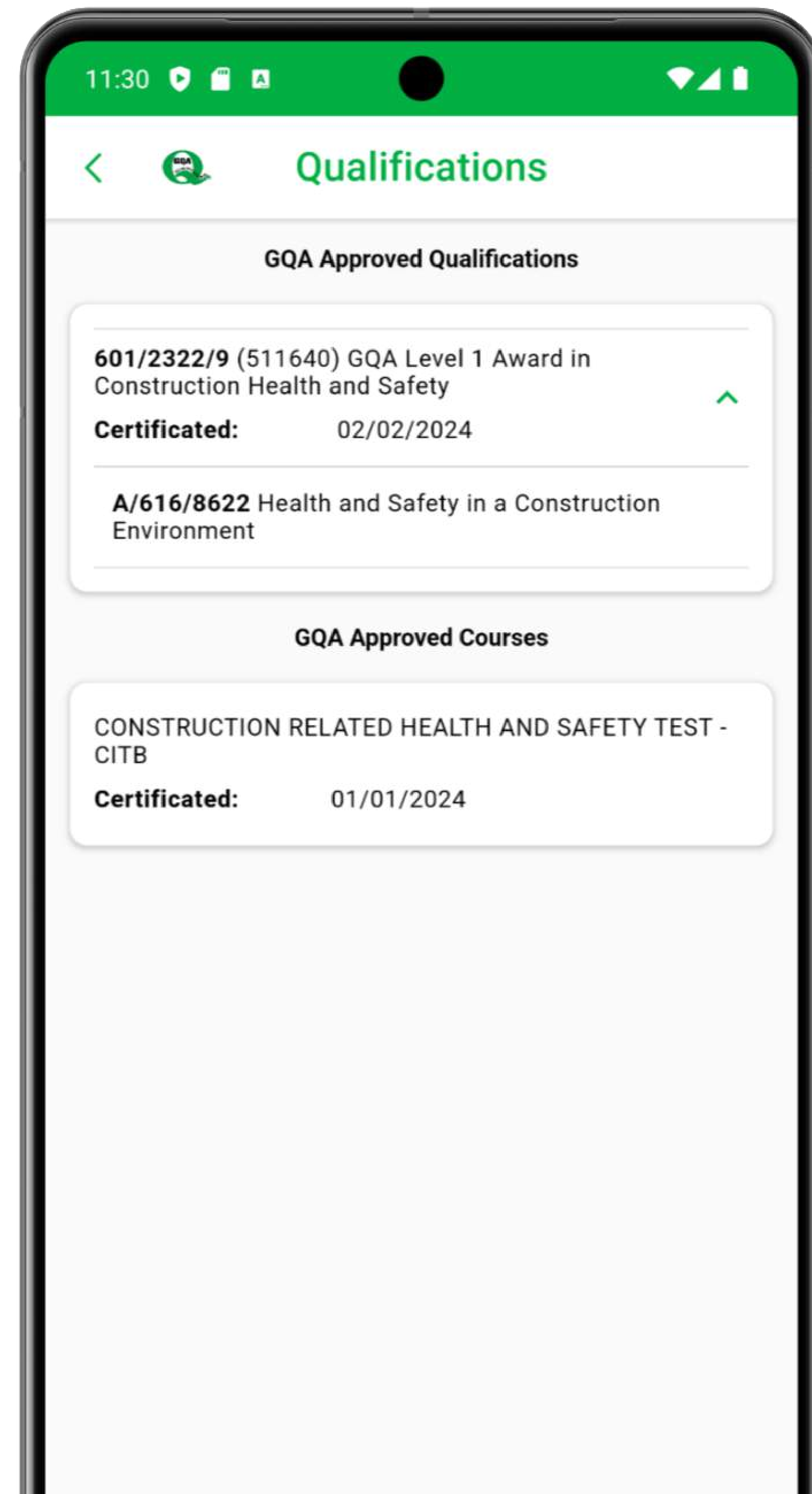
Key Benefits
