#### Who is this qualification for?

This qualification is aimed at individuals wishing to prove they have the level and range of knowledge and skills required to carry out damage repair and resurfacing in a construction working environment. Candidates must demonstrate the skills required when repairing and resurfacing damaged area: mixing, preparing, inspecting, polishing and blending. Candidates must be able to prepare and apply filler/compound to repair area and finish off to correct profile to match existing surface, to given working instructions, relating to texture, colour and hue and substrate and strength.

All work must be completed following Industry recognised Safe Working Practices and in accordance with relevant legislations.

#### Entry requirements

While there are no formal entry requirements for this qualification it is expected for individuals to working within a Waterproof Membrane Roofing environment and able to effectively carry out the required work to gather the evidence needed to complete this qualification.

This qualification is a Level 2, although some units may be at different levels and should be taken by those who are fully trained to deal with a range of tasks and situations.

## Qualification achievement

Although it is not expected that all workers will complete the same tasks, there are 6 mandatory units with a total credit value of 31 credits.

Qualifications are now required to indicate the total qualification time (TQT), this is to show the typical time it will take someone to attain the required skills and knowledge to meet the qualification criteria, this qualification has a TQT of 310 hours.

Qualifications are also required to indicate the number of hours of teaching someone would normally need to receive in order to gain the skills and knowledge to achieve the qualification. These are referred to as Guided Learning Hours (GLH). The GLH for this qualification is 164.

The unit of assessment sets out learning outcomes which describe what learners need to be able to do and understand. Learning outcomes are defined by assessment criteria which are used to assess competence, expressed as skills achieved and learned knowledge and understanding, to achieve the units.

GQA Qualifications will issue a certificate complete with the learner's name, the qualification and unit title(s) and the credits achieved.
